### **Mandate**

The Eastern Ottawa Community Family Health Team (EOCFHT) is looking to hire a Social Worker, Psychotherapist to work within our interdisciplinary team. Our primary care services are mainly geared towards helping members of the francophone community achieve total health.

The incumbent will work closely with members of our interdisciplinary team, including Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses and Allied Health Professionals. While respecting the limits of their scope of practice, the incumbent brings to the biomedical model a patient-centered psychosocial dimension.

### **Summary of Responsibilities**

Prevent and treat mental health issues and promote mental health to our treatment team and the community at large. Provide psychosocial assessments and offer short-term psychotherapy, psychoeducation and resource counseling (+/- 8 sessions) to patients of all ages (youth, adults and seniors) as well as to groups. Create and led educational sessions and psychoeducational groups to our clientele, team members and to members of the community. Participate in screening calls for new referrals. Help patients navigate the healthcare system and community services. Have in-depth knowledge of community resources as a whole and those specific to mental health. Act as a resource person to the treatment team for questions related to mental health and/or psychosocial issues. Participate in our team's monthly Memory Clinics. Share in the coordination of the mental health program. Actively participate in the mental health team's weekly meetings and work closely as a team. Offer mental health related education to students, residents and interns. Develop psychosocial treatment plans. Participation in one internal committee is encouraged. Stay abreast of exemplary practices in mental health care. Respect the EOCFHT's policies and procedures with regards to client service and general administration. Develop new initiatives to improve services.

- Master's in Social Work from a recognized university
- Member in good standing of the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers (OCSWSSW)
- Combination of education and experience leading to incumbent being recognized by the OCSWSSW to use the title 'Social Worker, Psychotherapist'
- Minimum five years experience in counseling or psychotherapy
- In-depth training in 2<sup>nd</sup> and/or 3<sup>rd</sup> wave cognitive therapies
- Experience leading psychoeducational groups
- Able to work both autonomously and as an active member of an interdisciplinary team
- Fully bilingual in French and English (oral and written)
- Experience using Microsoft Office, specifically Outlook, Word and Excel
- Availability to work one evening per week
- Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle
